



INSTALLATION INSTUCTIONS

- 1) Place the antenna (text facing UP) on your dash at the base of the windshield on the left side on vehicle is best away from wipers, if hidden antenna is wanted place on the left side away from wipers under dash plastic only not under any metal, some cars have removal front panel near windshield for antenna to be placed under for best coverage. Run the cables along the side of the dash at the door hinge, and place the transceiver box under your dash. For best results, consider using a zip-tie to secure the transceiver to ensure it doesn't fall from beneath the dash then Plug the two antenna cables and wiring harness into the transceiver unit.

- 2) Wiring the GPS Unit under dash.
 - a. Connect the **red wire to a constant 12 volt** line to fuse box
 - b. **Connect the brown wire to 12 volt accessory** wire in fuse box like the cruise control, etc. (one which only has power when the ignition is on)
 - c. Connect the **black wire** to a common ground like the frame or steering wheel.

- 3) That's it! The device is installed. For a more covert installation, you may place the antenna under the dash, all the way up near the base of the windshield, secretly out of sight. Our antenna can see through foam, glass, and fiberglass, but it cannot see through metal. For this reason, it is important that it be placed with no metal or wiring between it and the sky. The Best location is near the driver side left front corner. This allows being away from wipers and all metal in vehicle.
